PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Greetings!

The Board has completed an update of the Club Policies and Rules. We will be including reminders of some of the rules in the next few newsletters. This month we are highlighting some of the updates that have been made.

As you know, dues are now payable by Jan. 1st each year and interest will be charged on unpaid accounts effective January 15th. We also are encouraging Members to pay dues, initiation fees, guest room charges and other significant amounts by credit card, bank transfer and other electronic means.

We remind you that, until your dues are paid, you, your family and guests may not access the Club.

The Board has instituted a limit of 4 weeks for the length of time any one guest may use Club facilities in a year. This is a generous amount of time considering the limits and charges most private clubs put on guest access.

Courteous behavior is required at all times in the Club. The rules read, "Members and guests will use respectful language and maintain considerate sound levels (voice and electronic) that do not disturb other members. Members are responsible at all times for the behavior of their children, family-members, guests, and renters and will be liable for any and all damage caused by their children, family-members, guests, and renters (whether or not the member is present at the club with the guests or renters). Serious problems with family members, guests or renters may result in suspension or cancellation of the membership." Of course, members are expected to treat staff members respectfully at all times as well.
